Value Charades

Overview:

Topic Area: Group Values

Length: 30min - 1hr

Deliverables: Shared
Understanding of values

Players: 4-12

Instructions

Set Up:

Creating Value Cards:

1. Have each person write 3* values they care about on separate cards.
2. Collect everyone's cards in a container (ie: box, hat, etc).
3. Split up into two teams

Gameplay:

There are three rounds to the game. Each team is allotted 1 min to guess as many values as possible and then the container is passed to the next team. Each time the team gets the container a new team member picks value cards and gives clues according to the rules of the round. Each round is finished when all of the value cards have been accurately guessed. When a team guesses a value correctly they receive one point and keep the value card for the rest of the round. Return value cards to the container after each round, the team with the most points at the end of 3 rounds wins!

Round 1: team members are allowed to describe the value using any words and motions they like (except for the name of the value).

Round 2: team members may only use one word to describe the value.

Round 3: team members must act out or mime the value using no words.



Notes

* You may change the number of value cards that each person creates in the set up depending on how many players you have. We recommend that you reduce the number of value cards each player makes if you're playing with a large group.



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
